RULES AND REGULATIONS

DATE: AUGUST 18, 2018 FISHING HOURS: 6:00 AM TO 4:00 PM

WEIGH-IN 2:30 PM TO 4:00 PM @ TEQUILA SUNSET

AWARDS DINNER 4:30 PM @LOUIE'S BACKYARD SUNSET ROOM - S.P.I.

Registration Deadline: Registration forms will be received at the Harlingen AGC until Wednesday, August 15th @ 5:00 PM. Boat Captains or a boat representative must pick up a tournament packet either at the Captain's Party at 6:00 PM on Wednesday, August 15th or by Friday, August 17th before 12:00 Noon.

IMPORTANT: These packets will contain copies of the tournament and sweepstakes rules and regulations. Each boat will be required to sign off an acknowledgment of receipt and approval of the published rules and regulations. Additionally, each packet will contain each boat's meal/refreshment tickets and "boat number" badges which must be worn at the weigh-in and dinner. NOTE: Guests will not be allowed into awards dinner unless a dinner ticket has been purchased. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

NOTE: Tournament participants are strongly encouraged to attend the Captain's Party - Rules & Regulations for Tournament and Sweepstakes will be reviewed and discussed.

DIVISIONS WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:

1st, 2nd, 3rd place for Heaviest Red, Heaviest Trout, Heaviest Flounder in the Male, Female and Youth under 12 divisions.

(Heaviest red and trout contest is optional...see registration form.)

- 1) Eligibility: All AGC, AIA, ASCE & members, their employees and guests. Anyone who enters a guest must accompany that guest while fishing. (Maximum 5 persons per boat allowed).
- 2) All fish must be caught by rod and reel only.
- 3) In case of a tie, length will determine winner. Further tie breaker - 1st fish weighed.
- 4) All occupants of boat must be registered in the tournament. **Fishing Guides or Professional Fishermen are eligible, but must be a registered participant.**
- 5) Fishermen may launch their boats from anywhere they choose. We simply ask that you observe the honor system and do not begin fishing before 6:00 AM.
- 6) All boats must return to the weigh-in area no later than 4:00 PM or be disqualified.
- 7) Maximum length **redfish** eligible for tournament is **25"** (no tagged redfish allowed).
- 8) Maximum length **trout** eligible for tournament is **20"**
- 9) Maximum length **flounder** for tournament is **18"**
- 10) The official time will be kept by the Weigh-Master. The final decision and enforcement of all tournament rules and regulations will be made by the Weigh-Master.
- 11) Tournament participants may only have **ONE** line in the water at any given time.
- 12) **To encourage conservation, a live fish weighed in as your tournament fish will have 2 oz. added to weight and you will receive a ticket for a drawing for an ice chest. After weigh in the live fish must be released.**
- 13) Wade Fisherman must be in sight of tournament entered boat.

GRAND CHAMPION - ADULT & YOUTH. THIS DIVISION WILL CONSIST OF THE HEAVIEST COMBINED WEIGHT OF:

1 RED, 1 TROUT AND 1 FLOUNDER CAUGHT BY AN INDIVIDUAL REGISTRANT.

(AN ENTRY OF EACH SPECIES IS NOT NECESSARY TO WIN).

A PARTICIPATION TROPHY WILL BE GIVEN TO ALL ENTRIES IN THE YOUTH DIVISION WHO DO NOT OTHERWISE RECEIVE A TROPHY.
