



Personal Protective Equipment Outline 2 Hour Training Class



The purpose of this training course is to ensure the safety of employees by making certain that Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is provided, used, and maintained in a clean and reliable condition whenever necessary due to hazards present in processes or the work environment. To the extent possible and feasible, the employer or employees will strive to remove or eliminate hazards/risks or exposures through engineering solutions, thereby reducing the need for PPE.

This training course covers eye and face protection, head protection, foot protection, hand protection, and electrical protection. This training course covers the responsibilities of managers, supervisors, and workers, as well as the assessment of hazards, selection, and use of personal protective equipment (PPE), and training.

Each employee who is required to use PPE will be trained in the following:

- Why PPE is necessary?
- When PPE is necessary?
- What PPE is necessary, and any alternative choices of equipment?
- How to properly don, doff, adjust, and wear PPE?
- The proper care, maintenance, storage, useful life, and disposal of PPE?
